Nursing Assistant I

General Requirements:

- Must be 16 ½ on first day of class
- High school diploma or high school equivalency
- Valid driver's license or ID card with picture
- Social Security card (signed NOT laminated)
- All students need to be aware that this class has a hybrid component. Some of the class is online, but students will have in person class and lab. Clinical will be held at partnering locations.
- Computer skills are mandatory

Requirements before registering for course:

- Proof of vaccinations
 - o Hepatitis B vaccine (3 doses or sign declination sheet)
 - Influenza within current flu season (October-March 31)
 - o MMR 2 doses or evidence of immunity with titer
 - Varicella-2 doses or evidence of immunity with titer
 - TDAP -with the last 10 years
- 2 step TB skin test (2 tests 1-3 weeks apart)
- Current American Heart BLS

First two weeks of class:

- Urine drug screen
- Background check

If you know you will not pass a drug screen or background check, you may want to reconsider this course

Uniforms:

- Scrubs for clinical must be solid navy blue. Any shirt worn under your top must be navy or white. Lab jackets are not required, but if you choose to purchase one, they must be navy. Shoes must be leather (No Crocs).
