## 10.1 <u>Monthly Financial Reports - Jeanette McBride</u> *®*

Mrs. McBride updated the Board on the Monthly Financial Reports. She noted that State funds expenditures at the end of December were \$4,654,088 or 45.5% of budget which was in-line with expectations. County funds expenditures at the end of December were \$464,097 or 48.4% of budget, which was in line with expectations. There was \$467,410 available for capital expenditures and other grounds/building maintenance with a total of \$95,862 spent the first half of this fiscal year. The Institutional funds balance was \$1,240,008. All negative balances were due to timing of reimbursements with the majority being the \$68,671 due from the State for college wide security upgrades. The balance in the State Treasurer's Investment Fund account at December 31, 2023 was \$208,156.

For the month ending December 31, 2023 the total balance of all three accounts was \$4,667,462.06. As part of the Employee Annual Fund Drive, 85% of employees have pledged donations as of February 14, 2024.
