Jeanette McBride presented the college's Financial Reports for the month of August 2024. State expenditures totaled \$1,623,295 through the month of August, which is in-line with expenditures this time last year. County operating expenditures totaled \$165,523 or 16.5% of budget. The balance in the STIF (State Treasurers Investment Fund) is \$214,334.
