

Higher Education Relief Funds (HEERF) Application to Retake Course at No-Cost

The CARES Act, which establishes and funds the HEERF under Sections 18004(a)(1) and 18004(c) of the CARES Act to make additional emergency financial aid grants to students, provided that such emergency financial aid grants are for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus.

Students may qualify to retake a course at no cost to them in instances where a 2020 Spring course could not be completed for a reason directly related to COVID 19 and the disruption of campus instruction. All courses must be re taken no later than 2021 Spring.

To qualify to retake a course at no cost, students must meet the following criteria:

- Student received a qualified "WE" (withdrawal emergency) grade
- Received a High School Diploma or High School Equivalency certificate (e.g., GED®)
- Be enrolled in the spring 2021 semester
- Student must submit the 20-21 Free Application for Federal Aid (FAFSA)
- 2020 Spring Couse must have been a seated or hybrid section
- Be a U.S. Citizen or Eligible Noncitizen
- Possess a valid Social Security number
- Be registered with Selective Service (if the student is male)
