



Higher Education Relief Funds (HEERF) Scholarship Application

The CARES Act, which establishes and funds the HEERF under Sections 18004(a)(1) and 18004(c) of the CARES Act to make additional emergency financial aid grants to students, provided that such emergency financial aid grants are for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus.

Students may qualify for a scholarship towards their upcoming 2021 spring semester. This scholarship is available on a first come, first served basis until designated funds have been expended.

To qualify for a HEERF Scholarship, students must meet the following criteria:

- Received a High School Diploma or High School Equivalency certificate (e.g., GED®)
- Be enrolled in the spring 2021 semester.
- Student must submit the 20-21 Free Application for Federal Aid (FAFSA)
- Be a U.S. Citizen or Eligible Noncitizen
- Possess a valid Social Security number
- Be registered with Selective Service (if the student is male)
