

EMT Initial

Requirements:

- Must be 16 years old on the first day of class
 - o Must be 18 years old to take the state test
- Valid driver's license or ID card with picture
- Social Security card (signed and NOT laminated)

Requirements during class:

- Receive required vaccinations
- Urine drug screen
- Background check

If you KNOW you will NOT pass a drug screen or a background check, you may want to reconsider this course

Attendance

- This class is hybrid. Students will complete assignments and tests online. There will be five REQUIRED in-person skill days throughout the course.
- Students anticipating an absence should contact the program coordinator prior to that date with as much notice as possible
- Work missed during absences MUST be made up
- There are not excused absences from clinical. Students MUST complete ALL clinical hours

Books

- Books can be bought online
- You will need:

- Cost for the book is approximately \$125.00

Clinical Hours

- Each student will be required to complete 72 clinical hours on an ambulance. You will need to speak with the program coordinator regarding clinical sites, scheduling ride times, and completion of clinical requirements prior to beginning shifts.
 - o You will be required to wear the school designated polo shirt and black tactical pants for your clinicals.
 - Cost for the uniform is approximately \$50.00

State Exam

- You will register for the state exam on the LAST day of class.
- The state exam is \$70. The student is responsible for paying this fee. Payment can be debit or credit card ONLY.

EMS Courses- Vaccination Checklist

Proof of the following immunizations MUST be submitted prior to clinicals:

- Complete COVID-19 Vaccination Series (or medical exemption)
- Flu Shot during season (October 1 - March 31)
- TDAP- 1 dose within 10 years
- MMR- 2 doses or evidence of immunity with titer
- Varicella- 2 doses or evidence of immunity with titer
- Hepatitis B- 3 doses within last 3 years
- Two-Step TB skin test report (within 6 weeks)
