

# Nursing Assistant I

## Requirements:

- Must be 16 ½ years old on the first day of class
- Valid driver's license or ID card with picture
- Social Security card (signed and NOT laminated)
- All students need to be aware that this class is HYBRID. Most of the class is online, but students will come to class for lab and testing. Clinical will be held at partnering locations.
  - o Computer skills are MANDATORY

## Requirements during class:

- Receive required vaccinations
- Urine drug screen
- Background check

If you KNOW you will NOT pass a drug screen or a background check, you may want to reconsider this course

## Attendance

- Students are expected to attend ALL class sessions
- Students anticipating an absence should contact their instructor prior to that date with as much notice as possible
- Work missed during absences MUST be made up
- A student cannot miss more than 12 hours of class time
  - o Absences totaling more than 12 hours will result in a student being dropped from the course
- There are not excused absences from clinical. Students MUST complete ALL clinical hours

## Nursing Assistant I Registration Checklist

### These items will be needed throughout the course:

- Complete COVID-19 Vaccination Series
- Flu Shot during season (October 1 - March 31)
- High school diploma, transcript, high school equivalency (GED), or obtain required reading level on TADE Test. TABE Test MUST be scheduled and completed prior to enrolling
- Proof of Immunizations
  - DTP- 3 doses
  - TDAP- 1 dose within 10 years
  - MMR- 2 doses or evidence of immunity with titer
  - Varicella- 2 doses or evidence of immunity with titer
  - Hepatitis B- 3 doses or sign declination form
- Signed Social Security Card
- Valid E-mail address
- Two-Step TB skin test report
- Valid driver's license or ID card
